

UK and Republic of Ireland SIAM Section Guidelines for Student Presentation Prizes

Principal Guidelines

The UK/RoI SIAM Student Presentation Prizes are awarded to the student(s) who make the most outstanding presentations at a particular conference. This award is based solely on the presentation and content of the student's contribution to the meeting. The purpose of the Student Presentation Prizes is to recognise outstanding scholarship by students in industrial and applied mathematics.

Eligibility

Eligibility is restricted to students in good standing who have not received their postgraduate degree at the time of the conference. The conference organisers may ask contributors to provide evidence of student status. Submissions may be based on co-authored papers, but the prize will be allocated solely on the contribution of the presenting author.

Prize Committee

The prize committee will be chosen by the conference organisers, and will consist of a sufficient number of members to ensure that all student contributions in parallel sessions can be fairly assessed (using feedback from session Chairs, if necessary), with one member designated as Chair. The prize committee will determine its own procedures and rules of operations.

Award Presentation

The prizes will be presented by the Chair of the prize committee at an appropriate session of the conference.

Notification of Award

The names of the winners, along with the titles of their presentations, should be forwarded to the UK/RoI SIAM Secretary at the close of the meeting.
